

7th Annual CADCO Construction Autism Awareness Golf Tournament Raises Funds Again!

On Thursday, April 24th, MacGregor Downs Country Club hosted the **7th Annual CADCO Construction Autism Awareness Golf Tournament**, a sold-out event that brought together 128 golfers and dozens of sponsors—all united by one cause: supporting individuals with autism.

The tournament, founded and organized by **CADCO Construction Company**, has become a staple in the community's spring calendar, with proceeds benefiting **Building People And Communities (BPAC)**.
